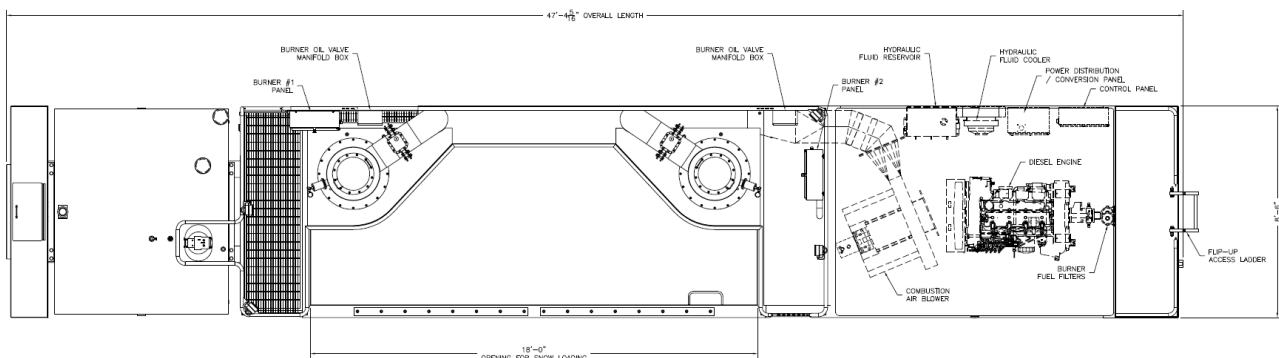


Features and Benefits of Treacan Snowmelters

1. Treacan is the only Snowmelter manufacturer that uses Submerged Combustion Technology which produces thermal efficiencies of approximately 98%, much higher than any other Snowmelter manufacturer.
2. Water temperature leaving a Treacan Snowmelter is approximately 1-2°C (35°F). Other Snowmelters with higher discharge temperatures require additional heat input. Heating the water to 16°C (60°F) would require an additional 9,000,000 BTU/HR or 242 L/h (64 GPH) of fuel. Treacan Snowmelters have much lower fuel consumption per ton of snow melted than other Snowmelters due to our higher efficiency.
3. Higher efficiency also means lower total CO2 emissions per ton of melted snow.
4. Only Treacan Snowmelters are equipped with a Remote Communications Package that allows for 24/7 diagnostic checks and trouble-shooting.
